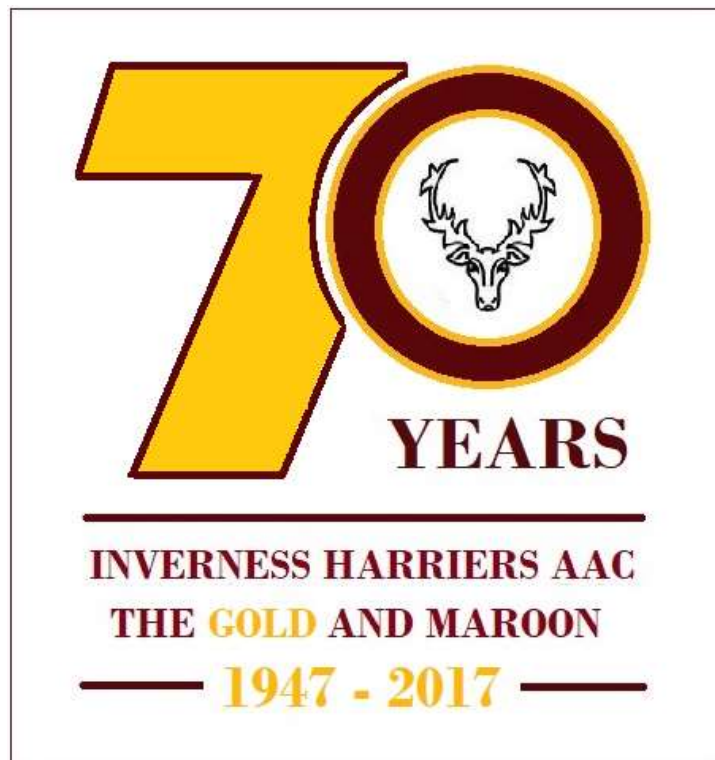

TOM McCOOK MEMORIAL SHIELD

Tom McCook – A cross-country enthusiast for the club and ran second claim for Aberdeen AAC. He later moved to Birmingham and went on to become Club President of Birchfield Harriers and such was his popularity and impact on the sport he was given the prestigious Ron Pickering Memorial Award for Services to Athletics in 2006.

CHARLES HUNTER MEMORIAL CUP

Charles Hunter – A club athlete in the 1950's who died at a young age in an accident. Until the 1970's, his mother would attend the AGM to present the trophy. Kathryn Nicholson (his niece) would later go on to become a harrier and win the memorial cup in the 1990's.

TOM MACKENZIE CHAMPIONSHIP CUP

Tom MacKenzie OBE - In 1947, the name of Tom MacKenzie enters the scene as the best known of three founding fathers of the club. In 1954, Tom became an Honorary Vice President of the club and as athletics enthusiast would later form Nairn Harriers, albeit this club would only last for an 18-month period. The club would later recognise Tom's contribution to the club by making him one of the first Honorary Life Members in 1988.

GEORGE BANNERMAN MEMORIAL TROPHY

George Bannerman – Helping with the resurgence of the club in 1975, George Bannerman held the first of many roles on the club's committee as Treasurer. In 1977, George would be elected as an "interim" Club President which would last for a 3-year period, after which he reverted back to the role of treasurer. George's service to the club did not go unnoticed as he was given one of the first Honorary Life Memberships in 1988.
