ROY PAYNE MEMORIAL TROPHIES

Roy Payne – After moving to the Highlands back in early 2000's, Roy and his wife Mary approached the club about becoming officials. The club are always welcoming when it comes to bringing new people into the club (whether they are new to the sport of athletics or not) and Roy and Mary joined the team of officials at the club. Mary is still an active official at the club and can be seen at track and field meetings, XC races and club handicaps. Upon Roy's passing in 2012, the 2 trophies were gifted by and presented annually by Mary to the Junior male and female athletes with the best performance of the Cross-Country season.

GEORGE MITCHELL MEMORIAL TROPHY

George Mitchell – A cross-country enthusiast for the club and an invaluable member of the Scottish team in the annual British and Irish Masters Cross Country International. Between his M55 debut in Cardiff (2003) and Belfast (2012), he never missed a race: ten in succession, a tremendous record and a testament to George's consistency and ability to peak for this important fixture. Further to support his cross-country mastery, George collected an impressive 12 individual medals at Scottish Masters XC championships, along with 2 individual medals and 8 team medals at British and Irish Masters Cross Country International meetings over that 10-year period.

PETER THOMSON MEMORIAL TROPHY

Peter Thomson – A club runner keen on the Club Handicap but especially so the Bught Handicap race which was historically the race held after Christmas break each year. This was the race where Peter could 'outfox the handicapper' and led to him being successful over this course. Upon his passing, his workmates decided to gift a quaiach to the club and is presented to the winner of the Bught Handicap race in his memory.
