Honorary Life Membership Policy – February 2023

Honorary Life Membership is a rare honour only afforded to exceptional individuals performing at a very high level or who have given long and distinguished service to the club, or a combination of both. It is not a default annual award.

Any nominations must be made to the committee by 31st July for inclusion in the AGM as opposed to an EGM. The committee will then decide whether to put the nomination to a general meeting of the club for approval.

Athletes gaining full Great Britain or Commonwealth Games selection shall be automatically recommended to a General Meeting unless the committee has good reason to oppose nomination.

Non-competitive members shall be required to have given the club at least 20 years' service for consideration.

The committee is also entitled to consider ***exceptional cases*** of a combination of high performance below GB senior level and at least 10 years' service as an athlete and/or a non-competitive member.
